

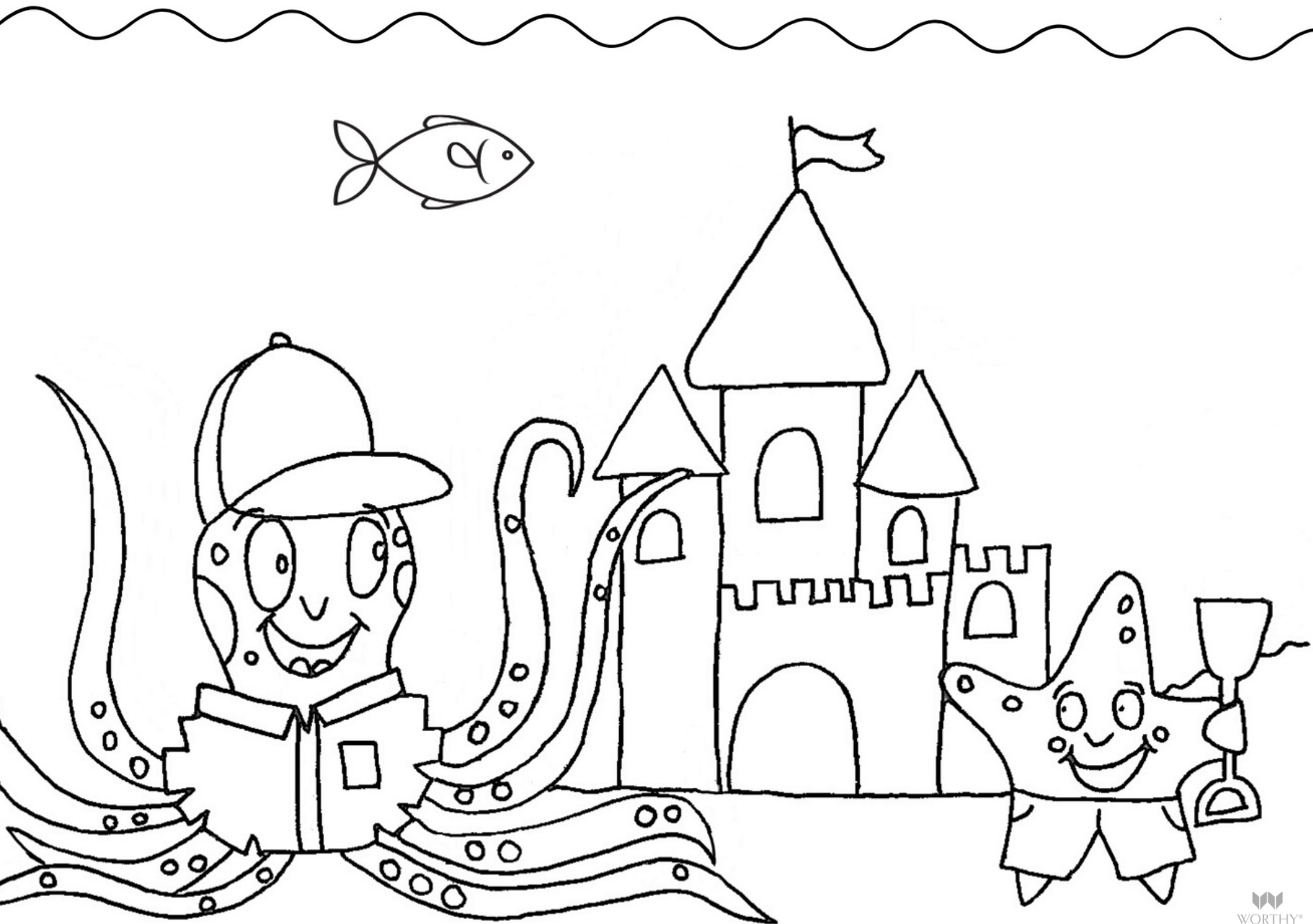

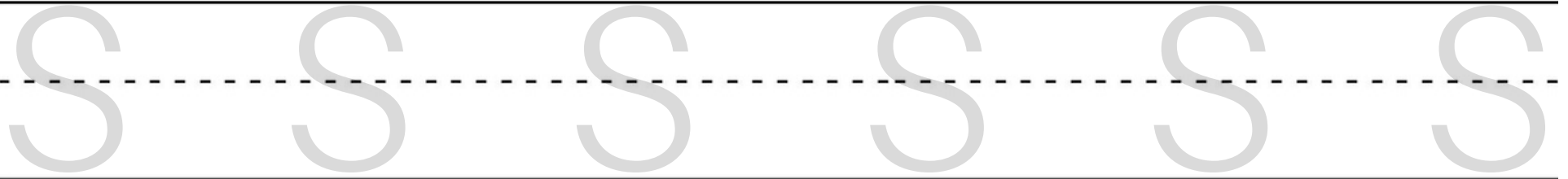
# Did you find all the differences? Here are the answers!
